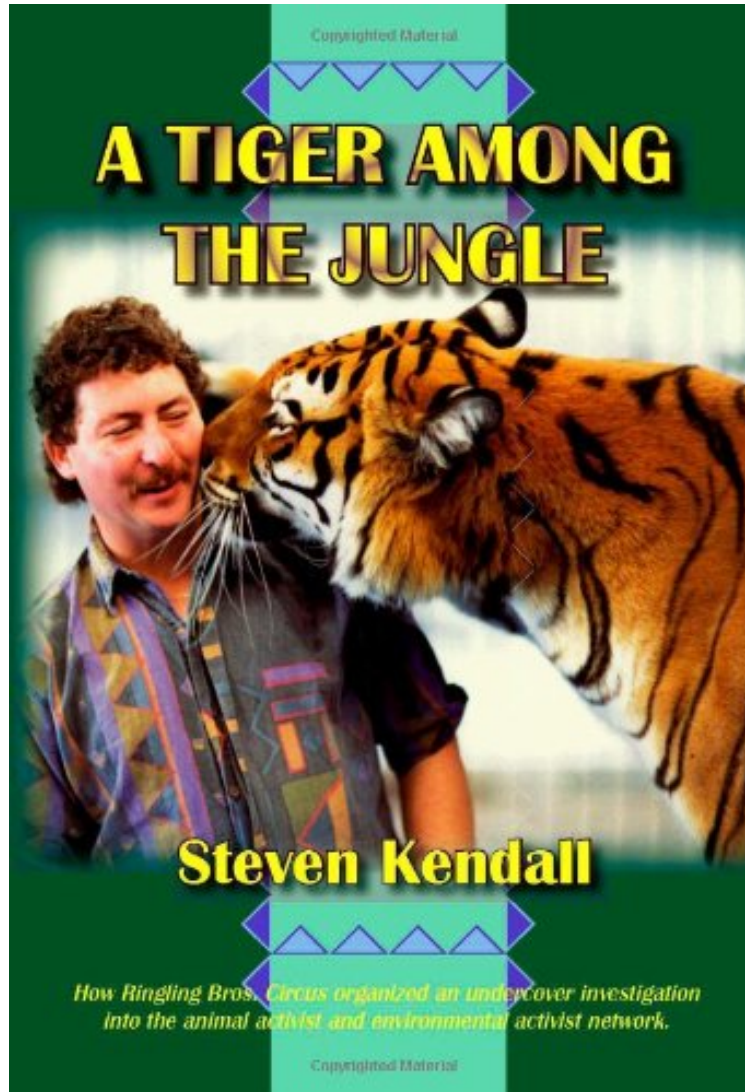

He also talked about "partying" in a strippers trailer park home while in Toronto to, again, fight against a local humane society. In that chapter he even admits to going through city council chambers on the weekend and photocopying their private files without their permission. The author seems to have a grudge against anyone he worked with that didn't do things his way from start to finish, and he lets his anger pour forth in this book. He also attempts to defend the abuse of elephants in the circus by completely avoided subjects such as the use of electric shock or food deprivation to make these wild animals do tricks.
