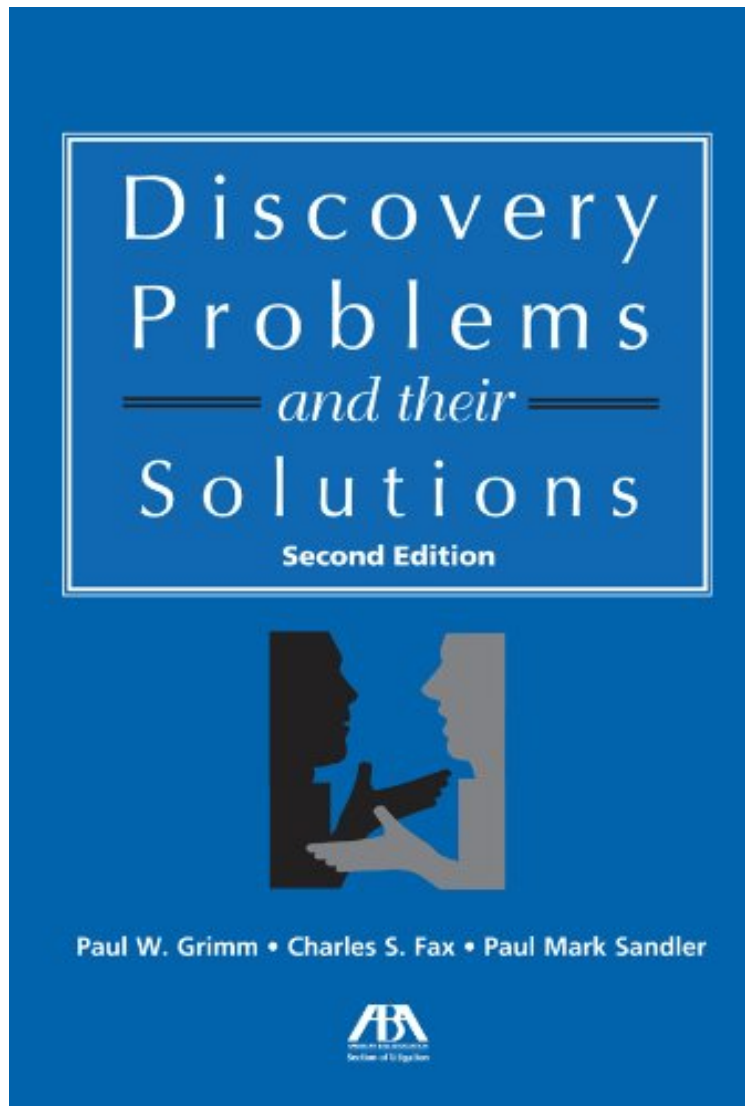

This book provides a good overview of discovery methods and then discusses the typical kinds of disputes and approaches to dealing with them. A strength of the book is that it is that one of the authors is a Federal magistrate judge who has seen plenty of discovery disputes.

The other authors are practicing attorneys. I have found this book a really good resource when dealing with opposing counsel who are seemingly unable to timely come up with documents, directly answer a simple interrogatory, or admit that the sun rises in the east and sets in the west.

This updated and expanded edition describes the problems that litigators encounter most frequently in pretrial discovery and presents suggestions and strategies for solving these problems. Following a discussion on the scope and types of discovery, discovery problems are presented as hypotheticals followed by a discussion that includes the law and helpful practice tips. Particular emphasis has been placed on the interpretation of the new rules, and evolving case law, concerning discovery of electronically stored information.
