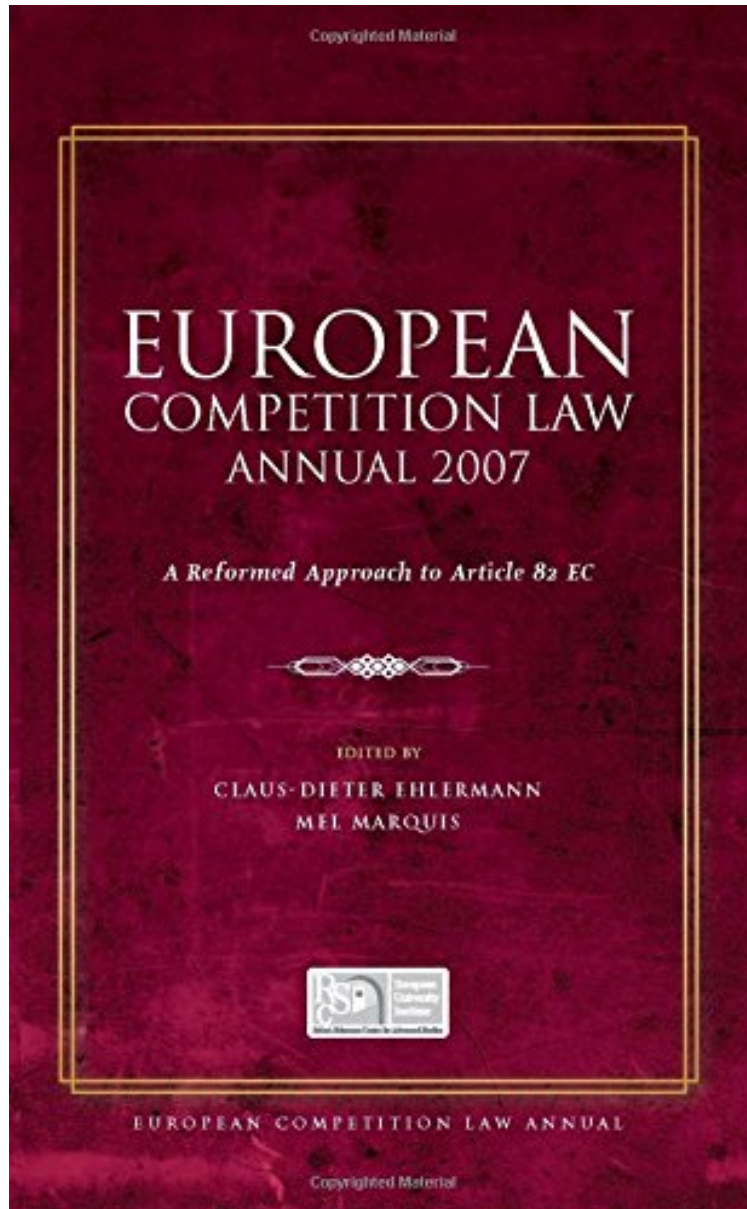

This is the 12th annual in a series of workshops on EU competition law and policy produced by the Robert Schuman Centre of the European University Institute in Florence.
