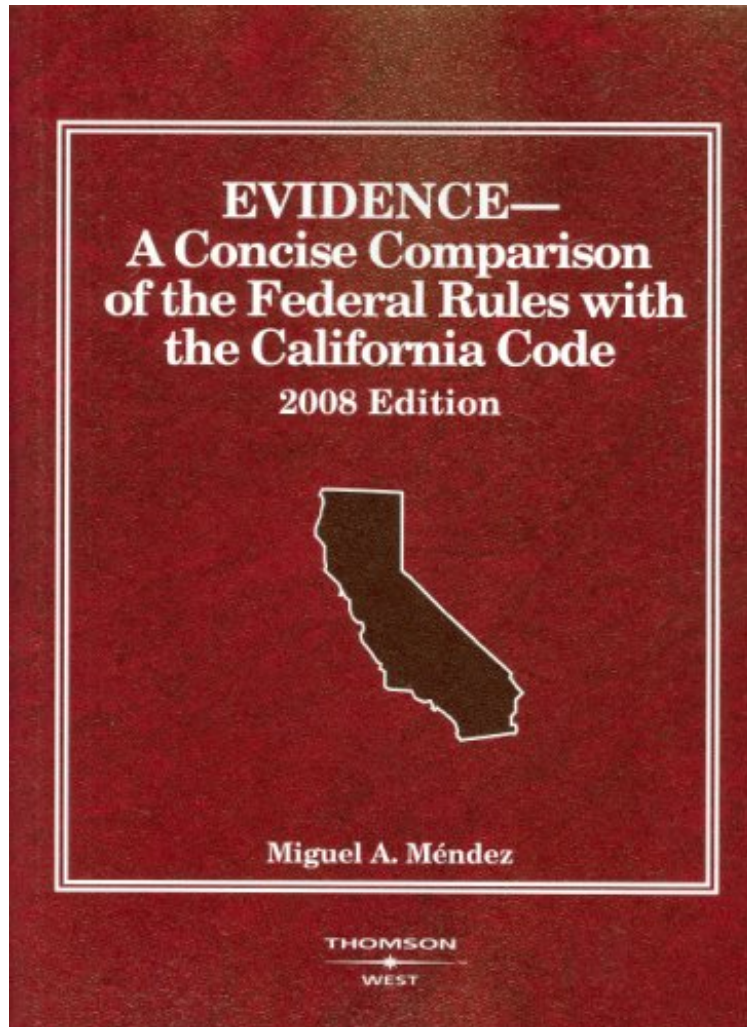

The rules aren't in any type of numerical order which

is what I was expecting, but when needing direct comparisons to CEC it has a lot of great notes. Mendez misses some minor distinctions or doesn't point them out (our prof noted about 2-3), so pay attention in class if your professor is expecting you to know every minor distinction. A helpful tip is to use this book to make a comparison chart between FRE and CEC and then compare the wording of both rules to really get to the differences between each rule.
